## “Terms and Conditions”

The 2024 Terms and Conditions are being posted on our facebook page and website this year. These terms and conditions will be modified as required, and they will be signed by all “new” campers coming in at the beginning of 2024. We will also have those receiving a first warning for noise or other infractions sign the Terms and Conditions so they clearly understand the document. If they refuse to sign the document they will be required to remove their property from the campground.

We will **high lite the areas that are added or amended each year** so everyone can follow the changes. ***Please read the Terms and Conditions***, and contact us for clarification if you have any questions.

## Swimming Pool and Spa

We had another successful and safe pool season last summer. Thank you everyone. With the no restrictions on number of people, with exception of maximum capacity of 56 people as authorized by pool size.

Each year, our biggest worry is that a serious accident will happen in the pool area. We need all the adults to participate in the safety of small children. Although it is primarily the parents responsibility, if everyone participates in a small way, such as reminding visitors of the pool rules, we will be able to maintain a safe environment for all children at Wildwood Park. We require all small children to wear an acceptable floatation device when they are within the fenced pool area. We have witnessed instances where parents take their eyes off their children for a brief minute and the child falls into the pool. Please ensure your children have the proper floatation devices to ensure their safety at ALL TIMES.

We would like to also remind everyone of additional pool rules.

- 1) NO GLASS allowed in the pool area.
- 2) NO RUNNING or JUMPING or DIVING into the pool.
- 3) NO ROUGH PLAY in or around the pool.
- 4) All **children under the age of 12 MUST be accompanied by an adult** in the pool area
- 5) No large floatation devices or wake boards allowed in the pool
- 6) No footballs or hard rubber balls allowed in the pool
- 7) Infants and young children must wear swimmers diapers at all times

PLEASE remind your family and guests about the rules in the pool area.

We encourage all campers not to hesitate to comment to others about safety rules. It is better to comment before something happens, rather than after.

Please note that pool hours are weekdays 11 am to 7 pm daily and Friday and Saturday 11 am to 8 pm.

## Pet waste stations

We purchased 5 pet waste stations last year and placed around the campground. The stations will contain free pet waste bags and a waste container to place the used bags into. These waste containers will be emptied after each weekend. We ask that parents ensure that their child can properly handle the dogs and that they are made aware that they must clean up after the dogs at all times. Please do not abuse these stations by taking more than the necessary number of bags needed and only put waste bags into containers and not household garbage. If stations are abused we will remove the stations.

## Drinking Water

Wildwood water, when coming out of the ground has never contained any bacteria. Water is filtered, then runs thru an ultra violet purifier and finally treated with chlorine. So rest assured the water is very clean and safe. Our drinking water is tested daily for proper chlorine level and tested every two weeks in a government approved laboratory.

Water will be available from the faucet, on the front of the green shop until the park water is turned on in May.

## Waste Water

We have to be extra cautious when handling the waste water. We must insist that all trailers attached to the sewer system must be hard piped from the trailer to our sewer system to avoid the leaking of waste water. We will be inspecting all trailers and install hard piping at an appropriate cost to the trailer owner.

## Safety Tips

- Drive slow—max. 10kmh
- Watch for children at all times.
- Slow down if you see children and adults walking or riding a bicycle on or near the road.
- Follow the one-way signs.
- Teach your children to play safe in the playground and pool area.
- Watch your small children very close.
- Do not hesitate to remind people to slow down.
- Keep a watchful eye out for your neighbors and their children.
- Do not park a vehicle on the playground area, by the stage area or on any road.

## Trailers 25 years and older

In 2024 camping season, trailers over 25 years can not be sold or gifted to someone, they must be removed, if you are finished camping at Wildwood.

Trailers can continue to be used by current registered campers past the above mentioned dates if well maintained.

## RM of Gimli Mobile Home & Travel Trailer By-Law

The R.M. of Gimli trailer tax fee is a flat \$80 per trailer as identified on your emailed invoice as MT.

The RM requests that leaves/grass clippings be disposed of in **biodegradable paper bag which will have clearly marked composite labels** on them and be placed separately from all other garbage for special pick up.

## Winter Storage

The winter storage fee will not be transferred to new purchasers. The purchaser will be charged the full seasonal rent. When selling your trailer the reduced amount you paid for the season will be adjusted upwards to the full seasonal rent and the purchaser will pay the \$300 extra.

## Before water is turned on

Please ensure when first going out to trailer in early May, that you DO NOT TURN ON HOT WATER TANK ELECTRICAL BREAKER BEFORE PARK WATER IS ON.

Each year quite a few campers turn on all breakers, including the hot water tank electrical breaker, resulting in a burnt out heating element.
